## Quick Steps: Shop > Shop Settings > Options > Shop Options

1. Login to the console, and select **Shop** from the top menu
2. Select **Shop Settings** from expanded left menu, then **Options**
3. Click **Edit**, then **Shop Options** from the tabs across the section
